

care	Accept an appropriate adjective, e.g. careful/careless/carefree/careworn

mess	Accept an appropriate adjective, e.g. <i>messy</i>
danger	Accept an appropriate adjective, e.g. <i>dangerous</i>
beauty	Accept an appropriate adjective, e.g. beautiful/beauteous

Also accept responses using capital letters.

Do not accept misspellings.





The chef said the pasta was uncooked.


This means that the pasta *has not been cooked*. This means that the pasta *is not cooked (at all)*.




