Charlie the Firefighter - Talk Cards **Answers**

- 1. Tulip Class visit the fire station.
- 2. Charlie is a firefighter.
- 3. Billy wanted to ride in the fire engine and Amari wanted to use the hose.
- 4. Children's own response, e.g. police officer, doctor, nurse, teacher, vet.
- 5. Charlie said she needed to be brave, strong and fit, and needed to work as part of a team.
- 6. The children were able to have a go on the fire engine, use the hose and look at the equipment.

- 7. The children thought Charlie was amazing, cool and incredible.
- 8. Child's own response.
- It is important to work as part of a great team because it helps all firefighters to do their job, even when it is difficult.
 There are some tasks that one person couldn't do by themselves.
- 10. The children had imagined that Charlie would be a man, but she was a woman.
- 11. The message of the story tells the children that they should be whatever they want to be when they grow up.
